COVID Precautions

- Temperature checks prior to entering the program.
- Face coverings required.
- Non-E-learning activities will be outside as much as possible.
- Frequent hand washing/ sanitizing for staff and participants.
- Designated workspace with assigned seating.

- Structured pick-up and drop-off procedures.
- Access to the area limited to park district staff only. Visitor access will be as needed only.
